

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- All children under the age of 13 years of age must be directly supervised by an adult.
- All children under the age of 6 years of age must be within arm's reach of an adult at all times.
- A baby or young child who normally uses a nappy **MUST** wear an aqua nappy.
- Observe and follow all signs. They are in place for your safety and comfort.
- People with communicable infectious diseases are not permitted to use the swimming pool.
- Immunosuppressed individuals should not use the swimming pool.
- Do not use soap, detergent or any other substance in the pools.
- Do not climb up, or onto any fence or railing within the pool area.
- Maylands Waterland accepts no responsibility for lost, stolen or damaged property.
- Appropriate swim wear must be worn at all times.
- The use of permanent shade shelters and BBQ's is free and available to all patrons however structured programs and bookings take priority.
- Staff have the right to inspect bags, containers and eskies at any time during your visit.
- The use of cameras is not permitted without prior consent.
- A valid concession card must be presented upon each entry in order to be eligible for the concession rate.
- Patrons are not permitted to bring glass items, alcohol or drugs into the facility.
- Any persons displaying abusive, disruptive or offensive behaviour and language will be removed from the facility.
- Any person suspected of being under the influence of alcohol or drugs will not be permitted into the facility.
- Maylands Waterland reserves the right to deny the use of personal equipment that is deemed to be unsafe within the facility.
- Maylands Waterland is a smoke free facility.
